



A COURTESY REMINDER

SPEED LIMIT WITHIN THE STREETS OF WILLOWBROOK FARM SUBDIVISION IS: 25 MPH

Homeowners or members of the WFHA Board are welcome to alert Novi police on the following:

Share the details of the offending vehicle's number plate, date, and time of speeding, **should they not be the first-time offenders.**

This includes those who do not live in the sub, however, may use our sub's roads to avoid main roads.

Homeowners may choose to counsel, should they know who was speeding, if one chooses not to report to Novi police.

WFHA Board and Novi police do encourage neighbor to neighbor counseling.

This may bring a broader effectiveness in keeping this menace under check, besides the Board's efforts alone, through constant reminders.

Increased level of patrolling by Novi police, at times of the day / night as appropriate, to monitor violations.

Conditions considered as violations: (some as applicable under **MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE (EXCERPT) Act 300 of 1949**)

1. Driving **beyond the prescribed limit of 25 miles per hour**, within the subdivision.
2. Vehicles parked **within six feet on either side of the mailboxes.**
3. **USPS's suggested guideline - Park your vehicle 15 feet from your or a neighbor's mailbox. Leave 15-foot space before and after your mailbox).**
4. Parked vehicles across the "**sidewalk**", inconveniencing pedestrians, including children and aged.
5. Parked vehicles **blocking the driveway** (will be subject to towing at owner's expense).
6. **Parking on the left, or facing traffic is illegal.**
7. **Speeding through construction zones** (within the sub during dept of public works or city of Novi related construction activities)
